Actions Taken or Agreed To Be Taken

- **New ePAG Introduction:** Marta Barańska introduced as the new ePAG for pituitary, focusing on Cushing's disease. Collaboration with Diana Vitali and Johan de Graaf to be discussed.
- **Data Submission for Continuous Monitoring:** Acknowledgment of efforts made by centers to submit data, including challenges in making the process more automatic.
- **CPMS 2.0 Update:** Greta Ginski provided updates on the transition to the new system. Discussion around hospital data protection approval and user roles (clinicians, non-ERN clinicians, assistants). Attendees were encouraged to update their expertise in the system for better case assignment.
- **Registry Project Update:** Loren van der Hoeven discussed ongoing studies involving the Panomen grading score and transcription factors in non-functioning pituitary adenomas. Mention of a planned meeting during the ESPE-ECE Joint Congress for preliminary data presentation.
- Webinar Planning: Planned webinars include:
 - Cushing webinar by Evangelia Charmandari (June 2, 2025).
 - Congenital hypopituitarism by Kristensen (June 25, 2025)
 - o Goal: Three webinars to be organized per year.
 - o Call for topics and volunteers to organize webinars.
- **Guideline Development:** Decision to shift guideline focus to congenital hyperpituitarism, with emphasis on pediatric transition. Collaboration with Charlotte Gaasterland for methodology and further discussions during the General Assembly.
- **General Assembly Preparation:** Suggestions requested for topics to be discussed.

- Chairs/ EndoERN: Continue development of the guideline on congenital hypopituitarism
