Congenital hypopituitarism






- Strong link with Transition of care


























# Additional remarks of responders

- A structured process should be in place
- It should be clarified what the additional value is of Endo-ERN endorsement







#### **Preliminary** conclusions

- Clinical content is considered most relevant for documents
- Methodological quality is also an important criterion
- Relevance for Endo-ERN is considered relevant for both documents and meetings
- Patient involvement is more important for documents than for meetings
