

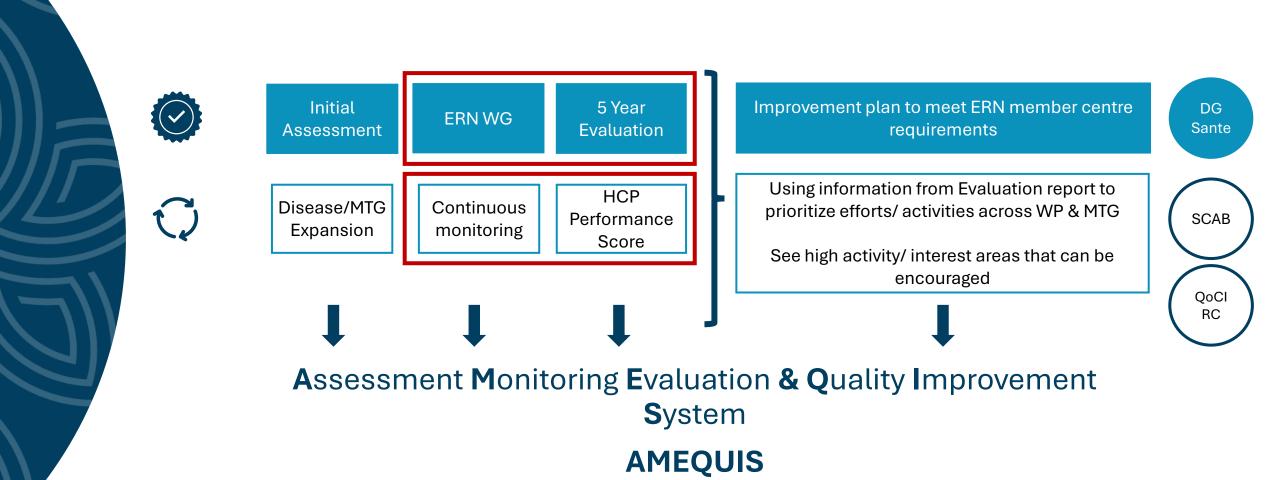

Continuous monitoring

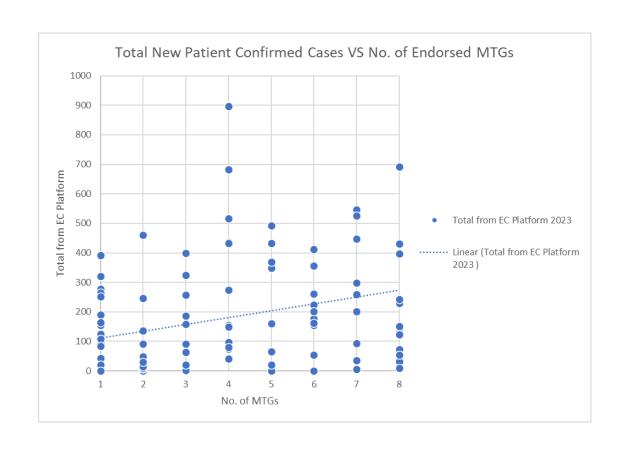
January 1 – February 28, 2025

12 HCPs reported same figures in EC Platform and e-REC

13 HCPs required us to report correct figures to EC during validation

HCPs had differences between e-REC total & EC Platform total

- 14 HCPs had a difference less than5 patients
- 16 HCPs had a difference more than 100

Mandatory in new grant

Updated annually following data gathering from CM

Scores our members on level of activity within/on behalf of the network

No extra collection from members

There are 34 activities that can earn a HCP points, categorized as Mandatory, Expected and Bonus

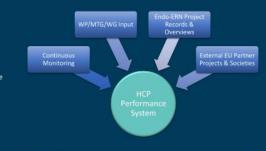

Endo-ERN HCP Performance Report 2023

This report is generated within the Endo-ERN HCP Performance system. This mandatory evaluation exercise assesses the activity level of each of our member HCPs based on information from sources shown here.



From our Continuous Monitoring exercise, in 2023 our network members have...



How do we calcuate your score?

There are 34 individual activities a HCP is scored on. These scores are weighted based on their category.

Possible Points

21 pts mandatory = 60% of total score 20 pts expected = 25% of total score 22 pts bonus = 15% of total score The resulting weighted values are used to calculate the overall Overall Score. Please see our website for further details.

Mandatory Activities = each HCP has to complet to retain membership (max. 3 points per activity Expected Activities = not mandated for membership but expected of contributing member HCPs (max. 2 points per activity)

Bonus Activities = (roles) undertaken by HCPs/ individual experts therein that advances our mission and seeks to improve the Endo-ERN (1-3 points per activity)





HCP Performance Reports

All HCPs in Endo-ERN received their 1st individual reports in August 2024

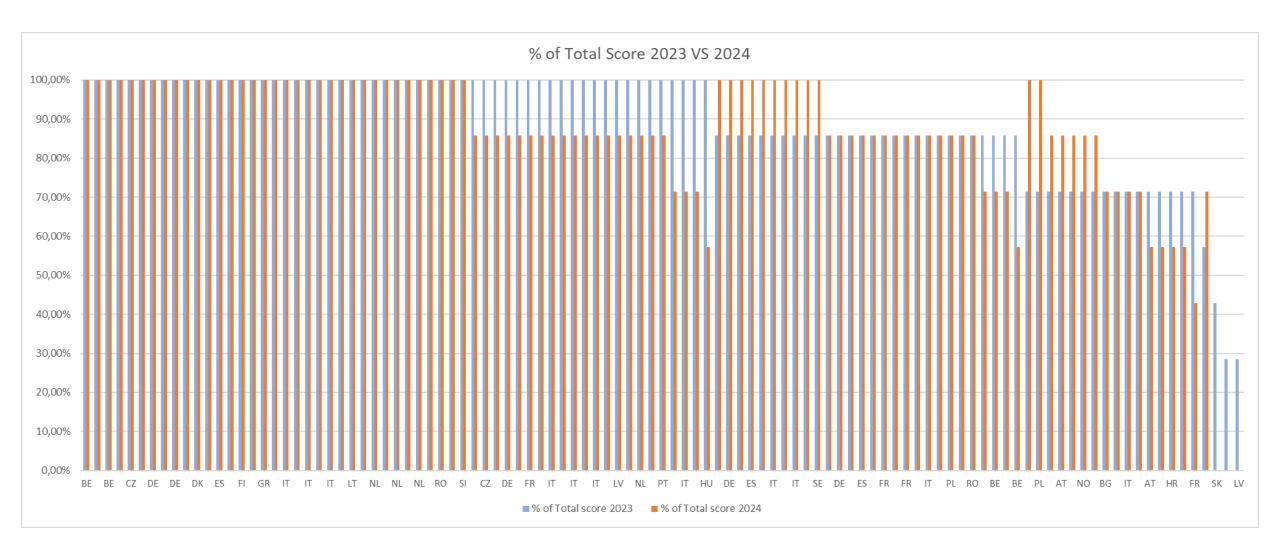
Excellent (100%) = 56 HCPs Good (60%>) = 46 HCPs Poor (<60%) = 3 HCPs

Positive reaction to the scoring and receiving feedback!

- Each **WP** will receive personal feedback in a general report
- MTG feedback from Continuous Monitoring
- 10 HCPs received updated reports/ scoring













HCP Performance System

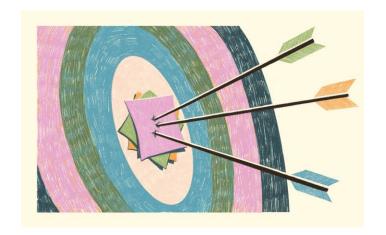
Updates this year:

- Performance Scores 2024 reported by Endo-ERN as part of Continuous Monitoring
- Only based on *Mandatory* activities

Excellent (100%) = 47 HCPs Good (60%>) = 54 HCPs Poor (<60%) = 4 HCPs

In 2023 vs 2024:

37 HCPs completed *less* mandatory activities 18 HCPs completed *more* mandatory activities

ePAG Evaluation





We would like to complement the HCP performance system implemented in 2024. As different activities are assessed for our member hospitals, in parallel we propose to check the activity level of our ePAGs.
