Work package 3 Continuous Monitoring/Evaluation

Overview for MTG2

HCPs endorsed for MTG2 = 48

e-REC reporting HCPs = 42 Continous Monitoring HCPs completed = 46

- 34 HCPs took part in at least 1 CPMS panels
- 44 HCPs have met the minimum patient requirements for MTG2 conditions

It is important to keep e-REC data up to date by year - end so the data accurately reflects rare disease patients in Europe
